ORDINANCE NO. 2032

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 1811 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2016, TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE TERM "ETHICS COMMISSION" WITH THE TERM "ETHICS BOARD" IN ALL PLACES IT APPEARS

WHEREAS, on January 14, 1997, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville adopted Ordinance No. 2016 which provided for certain language to be included on the May 20, 1997, Ballot relative to a proposed Amendment to the Home Rule Charter of the Municipality of Monroeville;

WHEREAS, subsequent to the passage of the Ordinance a term was used to describe the Ethics Board was inadvertently termed "Ethics Commission" contained in Section 1811;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of correcting the term to read "Ethics Board" instead of "Ethics Commission".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville as follows:

Section 1. Section 1811 of Ordinance 2016 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1811. Ethics Board

The Ethics Board shall be composed of three (3) individuals who shall be appointed in the following manner:

1. One (1) individual appointed by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville;
2. One (1) individual appointed by the Mayor of the Municipality of Monroeville; and
3. A third individual to be appointed by the Council Representative and the Mayor Representative.

All members of the Ethics Board shall sit for a term of two (2) years. In the case of a vacancy on the Board, and appointment shall be made to said vacancy by that body who made the original appointment prior to the vacancy occurring.


The Board shall conduct investigations on all complaints in accordance with the "Ethics Code" of the Municipality of Monroeville, Ordinance No. 1697 or as otherwise established by amendment or other applicable law.

Section 2. Any ordinance or resolution, or part of an ordinance or resolution in conflict herewith, is hereby repealed.


