**ORDINANCE NO. 2040**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF  
MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM AMOUNT FOR PURCHASE ORDERS  
PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIV, SECTION 1404 OF THE HOME RULE  
CHARTER**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville requested the Allegheny County Department of Elections to place on the May 20, 1997 Primary Ballot the following amendment to Section 1404 of the Home Rule Charter of the Municipality of Monroeville:

**Section 1404. Purchase Orders**

All purchase orders of the Municipality, exceeding a sum to be established by Council by Ordinance, shall be executed by the Manager. All other purchase orders shall be entered into in accordance with procedures established by the Manager; and

WHEREAS, the voters of the Municipality of Monroeville approved the May 20, 1997 Primary Ballot question, pending certification from the Allegheny County Department of Elections; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The maximum amount for purchase orders pursuant to Article XIV, Section 1404 of the Home Rule Charter is \$1,500.

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.


