

**MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 2045**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DEFINING AN UNANTICIPATED FISCAL EMERGENCY AS THE FLASH FLOOD OF 1997, FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPENDING "PARTIAL YEAR" FUNDS DERIVED FROM THE 1% SALES TAX ENACTED BY THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY PURSUANT TO ACT 77 OF 1993.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the County of Allegheny have enacted a 1% sales tax subsequent to January 1, 1994, as established by Act 77 of 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville has received "Partial Year" funds in the amount of \$106,136 from the 1% sales tax enacted pursuant to Act 77 of 1993; and

WHEREAS, the proper Municipal Official have established a budgetary reserve account for 1994 pursuant to Section 3156-B of Act 77 of 1993; and

WHEREAS, The Council of the Municipality of Monroeville has authorized the proper Officials of the Municipality of Monroeville to expend any "partial year" funds for unanticipated fiscal emergencies as defined by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville pursuant to Act 77 of 1993.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1. The Council of the Municipality of Monroeville hereby defines an unanticipated fiscal emergency as the flash flood of 1997 for the purpose of expending any "partial year" funds received from the 1% sales tax adopted pursuant to Act 77 of 1993.

SECTION 2. Any ordinance, or part of an ordinance, in conflict herewith, is hereby repealed.


