ORDINANCE NO. 2049

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF
THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ARTICLE III, SECTION 263.9
OF THE MONROEVILLE NOISE ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council
assembled as follows:


Section 1. The Municipality of Monroeville hereby adopts the amendments set forth in
the attached Exhibit "A" as additional unlawful acts regarding the Municipality of Monroeville's
Noise Ordinance.

Section 2. Any ordinance or part of any ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby
repealed.



EXHIBIT "A"

To be amended to include the following sections:

f. No person shall operate or cause to be operated, any audio amplification or reproduction device, including but not limited to an oversized hand carried radio, cassette, compact disc player, or one that is installed in or audio powered by a vehicle, on a municipal street or sidewalk, in a municipal park, on a public conveyance, or in any other public property which generates and A-weighted sound level in excess of 85 dB(a) in a residential area measured at, or adjusted to, a distance of 50 feet from the source. This subsection shall not apply to audio amplification devices used for open air musical concerts or any other private or public events.

g. No person shall operate, or cause to be operated any audio amplification system used for an open air musical concert or any other event, public or private, which generates an A-weighted sound level in excess of 85dB(a) in a residential area measured at, or adjusted to, a distance of 100 feet beyond the boundary of the property in which the audio amplification or reproduction system is located.

h. Sound levels under subsection a through g hereof shall be measured with a sound level measuring device, either Type I or Type II as defined by American National Standards institute Specifications. Section 1.4-1971.

i. A person operating an audio amplification or reproduction device shall be exempt from this section provided that:

1. The device is being operated to request assistance or warn of a hazardous situation; or

2. The device is an authorized emergency vehicle or a vehicle operated by gas, electric, communications or water utility; or

3. The device is being used in connection with a parade, political activity, amusement activity or community event that is being conducted under any permit issued by the municipality and is otherwise in compliance with the applicable sections of the Monroeville Code provided that the recommended sound level in the applicable subsection is not exceeded between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

j. Noise and sound as prohibited herein is a public nuisance, disturbing the peace and injurious to the public interest, and may be abated forthwith.
