ORDINANCE NO. 2088

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY OF THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, OPENING THE WINDOW OF OPPORTUNITY FOR BARGAINING UNIT EMPLOYEES UNDER THE POLICE CONTRACT TO RETIRE WITH A PENSION OF 65% OF THEIR SALARIES, AS DEFINED THEREIN, UNDER ACT 600 PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THEY MEET THE CRITERIA OF FIFTY (50) YEARS OF AGE AND TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE


BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1: Council for the Municipality hereby grants an additional window of opportunity from November 11, 1998 to December 31, 1998, the expiry date of the current Collective Bargaining Agreement, to provide for those Police Officers covered by the Collective Bargaining Agreement to retire at 65% of their salaries, as defined therein under Act 600, provided further that they meet the criteria of fifty (50) years of age and twenty-five (25) years of experience.


Section 2: The proper Municipal Officials are hereby authorized directed to implement this Ordinance effective immediately.
