ORDINANCE NO. 2153

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
ACCEPTING KELVINGTON PARK, RAMSEY GREENBELT PARK,
SHUMAKER PARK AND MADDEN PARK.**

WHEREAS, a review of the Municipal records reveal that Kelvington Park was dedicated to the Municipality of Monroeville at Deed Book Volume 4593, page 57; and

WHEREAS, Ramsey Greenbelt Park was dedicated to the Municipality of Monroeville at Deed Book Volume 4898, page 105; and

WHEREAS, Shumaker Park was dedicated to the Municipality of Monroeville at deed book volume 8152 page 001; and

WHEREAS, Madden Park was dedicated to the Municipality of Monroeville at plan book volume 51, pages 21 and 22 on "Longvue Plan Number 3"; and

WHEREAS, there is no record of any official Acceptance by the Municipality of Monroeville

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville that the following parks are officially Accepted for use by the Municipality of Monroeville and the residents thereof.

1. Kelvington Park D.B.V. 4593, p. 57
2. Ramsey Greenbelt Park D.B.V. 4898, p. 105
3. Shumaker Park D.B.V. 8152, p. 001
4. Madden Park P.B.V. 51, pages 21& 22 on "Longvue Plan No. 3"

Section II

The proper Municipal Officials are hereby directed and authorized to place the aforementioned parks within the jurisdiction of the Recreation and Park Advisory Board for use and access by the public and the residents of the Municipality of Monroeville.


