Ordinance No. 2155

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 194-20 of The Code of the Municipality of Monroeville is hereby amended to read as follows:

“The Municipality of Monroeville hereby eliminates the residential grinder fee as authorized by Alcosan.”

SECTION 2. The change shall be effective as of September 13, 2000.

SECTION 3. All other sections of the referenced Code shall remain unchanged in all other respects.



Any part the Code conflicting with any provisions of the Amendment are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, provided, however, that no rights to the collection of back charges or interest accruing thereon under prior sections of the Code shall in any way be affected by this amendment.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into law this 12th day of September 2000.


