ACCEPTING AN EXTENSION TO ST. VINCENT DRIVE**


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. The Municipality of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of an extension to St. Vincent Drive in the Monroe Heights Plan of Lots No. 7 and a total distance of 0.01 miles as more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.


Section 2. All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**ST. VINCENT DRIVE EXTENSION
STREET ACCEPTANCE
LAND DESCRIPTION
EXHIBIT "A"**

The Municipality of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of St. Vincent Drive as shown and laid out in Monroe Heights Plan No. 7, more fully described as follows:

FROM A POINT OF BEGINNING at the northeast corner of Lot No. 1, situated in the Monroe Heights Plan No. 7 of Lots, thence south $27^{\circ} 51'37''$ west a distance of 20.95 feet, thence to a point curving to the left at a radius of 45.00 feet and an arc length of 187.91 feet, thence north $87^{\circ} 07'10''$ east a distance of 49.38 feet, thence south $2^{\circ} 51'50''$ east a distance of 50 feet to the place of beginning.

The Municipality of Monroeville hereby accepts for municipal purposes all of the storm water and sanitary sewers servicing the lots adjacent to the streets herein above described and located within the said street right-of-way or adjacent lots together with any easement and additional right-of-way therefore shown on said plan, to be part of the storm water sewer and sanitary sewer systems of the Municipality of Monroeville. The grades for the streets accepted hereunder are hereby established as the existing grades, reserving however the Municipality of Monroeville the right to change such grades without liability to adjacent property or property owners thereof.
