**ORDINANCE NO. 2206**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A HOME RULE COMMUNITY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1900 AUTHORIZING AMENDING RULES AND REGULATIONS AND BYLAWS FOR THE MONROEVILLE SENIOR CITIZEN ACTIVITY CENTER**

**WHEREAS**, discussions have ensued between the Members of the Senior Council at the Senior Citizen Center of the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE to make various changes to the by-laws and rules and regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, Council for the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE deems it in the best interest of the Senior Citizen Center to approve said amendments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 1900 is affirmed in all respects to the extent it does not conflict with this Ordinance;
2. Article I of the By-Laws is amended to reflect the location and registered office as: 6000 Gateway Campus Blvd., Monroeville, PA 15146.

3. Article III, Section 1.2 of the By-Laws is amended to read as follows:

Individual participation in programs of the Monroeville Senior Citizens Activity Center shall be open to all persons 50 years of age or older.

4. Article IX, Section 1.0 Meetings of the By-Laws is amended to read as follows:

Meetings - Council is required to meet at least once per quarter per year. Each Council member must be made aware of any meetings by notice of the monthly schedule. Council meetings shall be at the Monroeville Senior Citizens Activity Center, located at 6000 Gateway Campus Blvd., Monroeville, PA 15146

5. Article X, Section 1.0 b. of the By-Laws is amended to read as follows:

All members are persons 50 years or older. However, the spouse of any member may be less than 50 years of age and may remain an honorary member of an organization as long as the member spouse is a member in good standing.

6. Paragraph 1 and 2 of the Rules and Regulations are hereby amended to read as follows:

1. The Monroeville Senior Citizens Activity Center is intended for persons 50 years of age or older. Council has the authority to approve exceptions for special occasions such as the flea market. Exceptions not requiring prior Council approval are: member's spouses, entertainers, caterers, handicapped government officers, local government officials and public emergency situations. Other exceptions regarding age must be submitted in writing to Council for consideration.

2. It is the responsibility of each Member Organization to ensure that all of their members are 50 or more years of age and reside in Monroeville or Pitcairn.

6. Paragraph 9 of the Rules and Regulations shall be amended as follows:


The regular operation hours are 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., Monday through Friday. The building is closed Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays unless posted otherwise. The building is also closed when the Gateway School System is suspended due to inclement weather.

7. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following Ordinance or parts thereof are specifically repealed;


8. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the [Governing body] that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
