ORDINANCE NO. 2226

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A HOME RULE COMMUNITY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1802 AND 1833 WHICH ESTABLISHES THE RULES GOVERNING THE FUNCTIONS OF COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE AND COMMITTEES THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Council and the Mayor of the Municipality of Monroeville, Allegheny County, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1833 is affirmed to the extent it does not conflict with the terms and conditions of this within Ordinance;

SECTION 2. Rule No. 7(b) shall be amended as follows:


Council will conduct "Citizens' Night and the Work Session" on the Thursday before the 2nd Tuesday (Regular Meeting Night) of each calendar month at 7:30 P.M. in Council Chambers of the Municipal Building. Any person or persons wishing to address Council may do so at Citizen's Night and every effort will be made to accommodate the individuals or groups wishing to be heard by all of Council. No formal action may be taken at Citizen's Night or the Work Session. The presiding officer and majority of Council may limit discussion within a reasonable time frame. Minutes will be kept on the names, addresses and nature of problems, important items of discussion and financial disposition of matters brought before Council at Citizens' Nights. of the recitals contained herein are incorporated herein and made part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following Ordinance or parts thereof are specifically repealed; and


SECTION 4. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Municipality that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
