ORDINANCE NO. 2232

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF
MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
A HOME RULE CHARTER COMMUNITY, ESTABLISHING
A POLICY FOR EARNED INCOME TAX REFUNDS**

WHEREAS, it has been noted that a significant number of Earned Income Tax (EIT) refunds have been made with relatively small balances; and

WHEREAS, Council for the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE seeks to reduce the volume of the Municipality of Monroeville's check processing and administrative costs concerning said small balances; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the staff that the Municipality of Monroeville implement a policy that the EIT refunds below a specified amount be credited to the taxpayer's account unless otherwise requested by the taxpayer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, the 10th day of September, 2002, as follows:

SECTION I. Earned Income Tax (EIT) refunds of an amount less than TEN DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$10.00) shall be credited to the taxpayer's account unless otherwise specified and requested by the taxpayer in writing.


SECTION II: All EIT refunds of greater than TEN DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$10.00) shall be refunded by check, as established by past practice.

SECTION III: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following Ordinance or parts thereof are specifically repealed; and


SECTION IV. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Municipality that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
