ORDINANCE NO. 2250

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF
MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A
HOME RULE CHARTER COMMUNITY, PROVIDING FOR AN
AMNESTY PROGRAM FOR ACT 511 MUNICIPAL TAXES**

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville, together with the Earned Income Tax Collector, are desirous of establishing a more pro-active policy concerning the collection of delinquent Municipal Act 511 Taxes; and

WHEREAS, as a prelude to the initiation of enforcement and collection of Act 511 taxes, the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of granting an amnesty program which will forgive the penalty only of any Act 511 taxes due and payable as delinquent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, this 14th day of January, 2003, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipality of Monroeville shall grant a amnesty program for a period of from the passage of this Ordinance until June 15, 2003, which will forgive any penalty due and owing and against the taxes, which are delinquent.

SECTION 2. The principal and interest due on said delinquent tax shall be payable notwithstanding this amnesty period without regard to penalties.

SECTION 3. Those residents who are eligible for said amnesty program shall be all those taxpayers who have never filed a return for Municipal Act 511 taxes, nor are they party to any present collection process already undertaken by the Delinquent Tax Collector.


SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following Ordinance or parts thereof are specifically repealed; and

SECTION 5. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Municipality that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
