ORDINANCE NO. 2294

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF
MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A
HOME RULE CHARTER COMMUNITY, ACCEPTING THE
DEDICATION OF THE MCCULLY HOUSE AND THE LITTLE
STONE BRIDGE PROPERTY AS HISTORICAL SITES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the

Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipality of Monroeville does hereby accept the McCully House on property situated on McGinley Road in the Municipality of Monroeville, Pennsylvania, and the Little Stone Bridge in the Municipality of Monroeville, Pennsylvania, the same to be operated and used as historical sites and centers.

SECTION 2. Any provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of the provisions hereof shall be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of the Ordinance shall remain in effect.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same effects this Ordinance.


SECTION 4.

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Municipality that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.



THE MONROEVILLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY, located in the Municipality of Monroeville, Pennsylvania 15146.

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement dated June 3, 1970, which assigned from the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE to the MONROEVILLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY certain historical sites located within the Municipality of Monroeville,

WHEREAS, the MONROEVILLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY thereafter began stewardship of said historical sites; and

WHEREAS, the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE is desirous of assigning additional historical sites to include the McCully House and the Little Stone Bridge to the MONROEVILLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY for stewardship by the society.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties intending to be legally bound hereby agree as follows:

1. The terms and conditions of the Agreement of June 3, 1970 are hereby affirmed and made part of this Amended Agreement
2. The MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE hereby assigns to the MONROEVILLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY the McCully House and the Little Stone Bridge under the same terms and conditions as more fully set forth in the June 3, 1970 Agreement.
3. The MONROEVILLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY shall hereby assume stewardship of said historical sites in accordance with the June 3, 1970 Agreement.
