ORDINANCE NO. 2344

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AMENDING ORDINANCE 992, 1802, 1833 ESTABLISHING RULES
GOVERNING THE FUNCTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE AND THE COMMITTEES THEREOF
BY ADDING A RULE AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF BOARD,
COMMISSION, OR AUTHORITY APPLICANTS IF NOMINATION FOR
APPOINTMENT HAS NOT BEEN MADE AFTER SIX MONTHS OR IF
NOMINATION HAS OCCURRED THE APPLICANTS SHALL NOT SIT FOR
MORE THAN SIX MONTHS IN NOMINATION

NOW, THEREFORE, on the 9th day of August, 2005, BE IT ORDAINED AND
ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:


SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 1802 is amended by adding the following:

Rule 20. An applicant for any Board, Commission or Authority who has not been
nominated after his/her name for consideration appears for six consecutive regular
Council meetings shall have his/her name removed from consideration for nomination.
In addition any nominated candidate that does not receive appointment to said Board,
Commission, or Authority after being nominated for six consecutive regular Council
meetings shall have his/her name removed for consideration for appointment. Nothing
precludes a qualified resident from applying or reapplying when a vacancy occurs on any
Board, Commission, or Authority.


SECTION 2. Any ordinance in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed to
