ORDINANCE NO. 2350

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF
MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA,
A HOME RULE CHARTER COMMUNITY, FORMALLY
CLOSING A PORTION OF JOHNSON ROAD, A PUBLIC
MUNICIPAL STREET**

WHEREAS, Council for the Municipality of Monroeville has been advised that residents and individuals are illegally dumping debris and waste from Johnson Road onto the lands of those abutting Johnson Road; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville believes it is in the best health, safety and general welfare to impede or otherwise prohibit said dumping.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED this 13th day of December, 2005 as follows:

SECTION 1. The existing gates that presently are installed on Johnson Road shall continue to be confirmed by this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The Public Works Department of the Municipality of Monroeville, or its designee, are hereby authorized and directed to install a new gate on the site as located on a map, which map is known as "Johnson Road Partial Closure Location Map". Said map is attached hereto marked Exhibit No. "A" and made part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Effective the date of this Ordinance, Johnson Road will be formerly closed from a location at the new gate site then in a southerly direction to the Kenney Avenue existing gate on said drawing near the dividing line of Pitcairn and Monroeville, and shall remain closed until such time as Council may in its discretion again open Johnson Road by Ordinance.


SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Commissioners that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


