**AND NOW**, on February 14, 2006 Municipal Council of the Municipality of Monroeville hereby **ORDAINS AND ENACTS** as follows:


**SECTION 1.** The fee schedule of the Municipality of Monroeville attached hereto is hereby approved and shall be implemented, effective immediately.

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**BUILDING/CONSTRUCTION FEES:****SECTION 1: BUILDING AND OTHER STRUCTURE PERMIT FEES**

*The Schedule of Fees hereinafter set shall be charged in the respective use group categories as defined by the most recently adopted edition of the BOCA Building Code for issuance of permits for the construction of buildings and other structures within the Municipality of Monroeville where permits are required pursuant to any Ordinance or other action of the Municipality.*

**BUILDING PERMIT:**

**USE GROUP:** R-4 Residential and those buildings and structures in U, Utility and Miscellaneous, which are accessory to the R-4, Residential Use Group.

.25 per square foot of gross floor area.

**MINIMUM BUILDING PERMIT FEE: \$40.00**

**USE GROUP:** All others, including: A, Assembly; B, Business; E, Educational; F, Factory and Industrial; H, High Hazard; I, Institutional; ; M, Mercantile, R-1, Residential; R-2, Residential; R-3, Residential, S, Storage; and those buildings and structures in U, Utility and Miscellaneous, which are accessory to the above listed use groups.

.30 per square foot of gross floor area.

**MINIMUM BUILDING PERMIT FEE: \$80.00**

**RE-INSPECTION FEE:** For re-inspection of scheduled inspection that work is not complete

**USE GROUP:** R-4 residential and those buildings and structures in U, Utility and miscellaneous, which are accessory to the R-4, residential use group.

**RE-INSPECTION FEE: \$40.00**

**USE GROUP:** All others, including: A, Assembly; B, Business; E, Educational; F, Factory and Industrial; H, High Hazard; I, Institutional; ; M, Mercantile, R-1, Residential; R-2, Residential; R-3, Residential, S, Storage; and those buildings and structures in U, Utility and Miscellaneous, which are accessory to the above listed use groups.

**RE-INSPECTION FEE: \$50.00**

**REVIEW FEE:** For review of building plans and site plans for which a building permit has not been issued, the cost shall be as follows:

**BUILDING OCCUPANCY PERMIT:**

**USE GROUP:** R-4, Residential, and those buildings and structures in U, Utility and miscellaneous, which are accessory to the R-4 Residential use group.

\$30.00 per Residential Unit.

**USE GROUP:** R-1, R-2, R-3, Residential use groups, and those buildings and structures in U, Utility and Miscellaneous, which are accessory to the above listed use groups.

\$100.00 plus \$30.00 per residential unit.

All others, including: A, Assembly; B, Business; E, Educational; F, Factory and Industrial; H, High Hazard; I, Institutional; M, Mercantile; S, Storage; and Those Buildings and structures in U, Utility and Miscellaneous, which are accessory to the above listed use groups.

A flat fee of \$100.00 for a new or revised building site for which a site inspection has not been conducted plus \$100.00 and .05 per square foot of gross floor area.

For all other, \$100.00 plus .05 per square foot of gross floor area.

## **SECTION 2: ROOF REPLACEMENT, REPAIR AND ALTERATION**

The permit application fee for replacement, repair or alteration of the roof of an existing structure shall be as follows:

- a. For structures classified in use group categories R-3 and R-4 in the BOCA Basic Building Code as adopted by the Municipality of Monroeville the sum of \$35.00
- b. For structures classified other than Use Group categories R-3 and R-4 in the BOCA Building Code as adopted by the Municipality of Monroeville, the fee of \$130.00.

## **SECTION 3: APPLICATION OR REZONING AND ZONING ORDINANCE CHANGES**

A fee of \$1,000.00 plus \$50.00/acre shall be charged by the Municipality of Monroeville for applications for change of zoning and for changes to the text of the Zoning Ordinance.

Additional costs can be assessed for stenographic. Legal and expert service when required.

## **SECTION 4: APPLICATION FOR CONDITIONAL USES**

A fee of \$500.00 plus \$0.02 per square foot area of structure or the cubic yards of earth moved and \$800.00 for conditional uses with no structure shall be charge by the Municipality of Monroeville for the acceptance of applications for consideration of conditional uses as set forth in the Zoning Ordinance.

## **SECTION 5: PETITIONS TO VACATE STREET**

A fee of \$325.00 shall be charged by the Municipality of Monroeville for the acceptance of a petition to vacate any street or portion thereof. Where two or more touching streets are included in the same petition, only one such fee shall be charged.

## **SECTION 6: APPLICATIONS OR SUB-DIVISION APPROVAL**

A fee of \$50.00 per lot shall be charged by the Municipality of Monroeville or any sub-division application.

The entire charge shall be due and payable upon presentation of the preliminary plan. No additional charge shall be made or the final plan as presented to Municipal Council for approval unless such final plan contains a larger number of lots than the prelliminary plan. In such event an additional charge shall be made at the same rates based upon the additional number of lots in the final plan.

## **SECTION 7: APPLICATIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF STREET**

A flat fee of \$325.00 per application shall be charged by the Municipality of Monroeville for the acceptance of any street or portion thereof. Where two or more touching streets are involved in the same application, only one such fee shall be charged.

## **SECTION 8: RETAINING WALLS**

The permit application fees for retaining walls shall be as follows:

- \$1.50 for each linear foot of wall 3 feet or less in height.
- \$1.75 for each linear foot of wall 4 feet in height.
- \$2.00 for each linear foot of wall 5 feet in height.
- \$2.25 for each linear foot of wall 6 feet in height.
- \$2.50 for each linear foot of wall exceeding 6 feet in height.

No permit application fee shall be charged for a permit application for a retaining wall located on property where the only structures thereon or to be placed thereon are classified in use groups R-3 or R-4 in the BOCA Basic Building Code adopted by the Municipality of Monroeville, unless the purpose of said retaining wall is to protect adjacent or contiguous property.

### **SECTION 9: INTERIOR PARTITIONS**

The permit application fee for the erection, installation or removal of any interior partition in an existing structure shall be \$21.50 per 100 square feet (or any fraction thereof) of the surface area of any partition to be erected or installed or of any partition to be removed or altered, either in whole or part.

### **SECTION 10: MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT AND ELECTRIC WIRING AND EQUIPMENT**

The permit application fee for the replacement or alteration of mechanical equipment or electric wiring and equipment will be as follows:

- (a) Heating and ventilation (including chimneys, flues and vent pipes) - \$45.00
- (b) Elevators, dumbwaiters and conveyor equipment - \$210.00
- (c) Escalators - \$210.00
- (d) Electric wiring and equipment - \$110.00
- (e) Electric wiring and equipment, including boiler rooms drying rooms, refuse chutes and vaults and dust, stock and refuse conveyor systems - \$110.00

### **SECTION 11: APPLICATIONS OR RAZING AND/OR DEMOLITION WORK**

- a. A fee of \$80.00 shall be charged for the application for permit for the demolition and/or razing work on any structure having a floor area of 2,000 square feet or less.
- b. A fee of \$80.00 plus \$20.00 for each 1,000 square feet of floor area or fraction thereof for demolition and/or razing of any structure having a floor area in excess of 2,000.
- c. Any applicant receiving a permit under this section shall post a performance bond with the Municipality in an amount not less than the amount of the contract for the demolition or razing work. The same bond shall secure the workmanlike performance of the work authorized by the permit in accordance with all applicable laws and ordinances.
- d. Prior to the issuance of any such permit the applicant shall submit to the Municipality evidence of notice of the intended work or any an all property owners who may or could be affected by such work.
- e. Any individual or entity performing any work pursuant to a permit issued under this section shall be exempt from any fee if the work being performed is done pursuant to action initiated by Monroeville Municipality.

### **SECTION 12: MOVING OF STRUCTURES WITHIN OR OUTSIDE OF THE MUNICIPALITY**

- a. A fee of \$75.00 shall be charged for the application for any permit for the moving of any structure from within the Municipality outside the Municipality. This fee shall apply to any structure having a floor area measured by exterior dimensions of 2,000 square feet or less.
- b. A fee of \$75.00 plus \$20.00 for each 1,000 square feet of floor area or fraction thereof for demolition or razing work of any structure shall be charged for any such structure having a floor area in excess of 2,000 square feet.
- c. Any applicant desiring to move any such structure shall acquire a no lien letter before the issuance of any such permit and existing liens recorded or unrecorded shall be paid in full prior to the issuing of any such permit.
- d. Any applicant receiving a permit under this section shall post a performance bond with the Municipality naming it as beneficiary which bond shall be in an amount not less than the amount of the contract for the moving of the structure and the placement of the same upon a designated foundation.

- e. If any structure is moved within the Municipality there shall also be required in addition to the permit under this section a building permit in an amount to be determined by the square footage of the new foundation as per the fee requirements of this ordinance.
- f. Prior to the issuance of any permit under this section the applicant shall submit to the Municipality evidence of notice to any and all affected property owners and those having leasehold interest which notice shall give ample warning of the intended use of the structure and discontinuance no matter how minimal of utility.

**SECTION 14:** **SUBSURFACE AND SURFACE FACILITY INSTALLATIONS**

The term "line" as used herein means an underground conductor used in providing electric or communications service, or an underground pipe used in providing gas, oil or oil product delivery, sewage, water or other service to one or more consumers of such service.

**SECTION 18: ENGINEER INSPECTION FEE**

The fee for inspection of street and highways by the Consulting Municipal Engineer shall be \$40.00 per hour.

**SECTION 19: APPLICATIONS FOR SITE PLAN APPROVAL**

For a Site Plan approving a new structure or an addition to an existing structure a fee of \$300 shall be charged plus \$0.02 (2 cents) per square foot of the proposed structure or addition to the existing structure. For a site plan without a structure or an existing structure to which no addition is proposed a flat fee of \$500.00 shall be charged.

**SECTION 20: APPLICATION FOR ANY PROCEEDING BEFORE THE BOCA BOARD OF APPEALS.**

A flat fee of \$200.00 shall be charged for the acceptance of applications for any type of proceeding before the BOCA Board of Appeals.

**SECTION 21: APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF NON-CONFORMANCE**

A flat fee of \$25.00 shall be charged for the acceptance of any application for a Certificate of Non-Conformance.

**SECTION 22: APPLICATION FOR SIGN PERMITS**

A flat fee of \$50.00 + \$2.00 per square foot per face shall be charged for any ground sign.

A flat fee of \$50.00 + \$2.00 per square foot shall be charged for any wall or roof sign.

A flat fee of \$100.00 is charged for any temporary sign.

A flat fee of \$100.00 is charged for special promotional balloons and other inflatable signs.

**SECTION 23: All permits issued shall be required as set forth in the BOCA Basic Building Code and/or Fire Prevention Code as may be amended and adopted by the Monroeville Municipality and if otherwise lawful shall be issued in accordance with fee schedule herein set forth.**

**SECTION 24: All fees as set forth in this Ordinance shall be due and payable at the time any application is accepted and any bond required herein or otherwise shall be posted with the Municipality prior to the issuance of any permit.**

**SECTION 25: TEMPORARY STRUCTURES**

All temporary structures to include tents and trailers for a period not to exceed sixty days.

Tent Fee: \$100.00

Trailer Fee: \$300.00

Any extension of time must be approved by the Zoning Hearing Board with a subsequent renewal fee of \$200.00.

**COPYING FEES\*:**

Ordinances consisting of one (1) to ten (10) pages - twenty five (.25) cents per page with a minimum of \$2.00.

Any Ordinances that must be delivered through the U.S. Mail - \$5.00.

Specific Communications and Ordinances that require research - A charge would be made for staff time and reproduction cost at an hourly rate with a minimum charge of twenty (\$20.00) dollars.

GIS Information-\$100.00 per tile (delivered electronically)

## **FORMULA FOR CALCULATING PERSONNEL RATES:**

Total of employee's Hourly rate (per hour or per overtime hour), plus costs for Social Security, Medicare, Workers Compensation Insurance, Health, Pension State Unemployment Compensation Tax, Life Insurance, Longevity and any Material Cost.

Examples of charges billed: Insurance Claims, Police, Engineering, Public Works, etc.

## **LAND DISTURBANCE**

### **I. MINOR EXCAVATIONS/MINOR TIMBERING AND LOGGING OPERATION**

- a. A fee of \$15.00 shall be charged for the application for permit for minor excavation involving 100 cubic yard of earth or less. A minimum bond of \$80.00 shall be deposited with the Municipality to guarantee the completion of the work.
- b. A fee of \$125.00 shall be charged for the application for permit for minor excavation involving 5,000 cubic yards of earth or less.

- c. A fee of \$125.00 plus \$15.00 for every 1,000 additional cubic yards of earth moved shall be charged for any minor excavation involving excavation of more than 5,000 cubic yards of each but less than required for major excavation as defined by the Monroeville Zoning Ordinance.
- d. A fee of \$200.00 shall be charged for the application for permit for any minor timbering and logging operation.
- e. A bond of \$2,500.00 per acre shall be deposited with the Municipality of Monroeville to guarantee the restoration of property.
- f. Additional cost can be assessed for engineering review, legal and expert service when required.

## II. MAJOR TIMBERING AND LOGGING OPERATION

- a. An application Fee of \$1,000 shall be charged by the Municipality of Monroeville for any application for a Major Timbering and Logging Operation as defined in the Land Disturbance Ordinance.
- b. A review Fee Deposit of \$1,000 shall be required at the time of submission for a Major Timbering and Logging Operation as defined in the Land Disturbance Ordinance.
- c. An Appeal to the Decision of the Municipal Engineer shall be \$1,000 plus \$100 per acre.
- d. A review Fee Deposit of \$2,000 shall be required at the time of submission for an Appeal to the Decision of the Municipal Engineer.
