ORDINANCE NO. 2414

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF
MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, A HOME RULE CHARTER
COMMUNITY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2188
KNOWN AS MONROEVILLE'S NOISE CONTROL
ORDINANCE, TO INCLUDE NOISE LEVEL LIMITS
FOR S-1 CONSERVANCY ZONING DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE currently has in place a
Noise Control Ordinance, known as Ordinance 2188, as amended, which Council for the
Municipality of Monroeville has determined that loud, excessive and unreasonable noise
constitutes a serious threat to the health, safety and welfare of its residents.

WHEREAS, the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE desires to amend the
Noise Control Ordinance to include noise level limits for the S-1 Conservancy Zoning
District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, the
MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE makes the following amendments to it Noise
Control Ordinance known as Ordinance No. 2188:

SECTION 1. ARTICLE THREE: NOISE LEVEL LIMITS AND
MEASUREMENTS, TABLE 301, Noise Level Limits, NLL shall
read as follows:


