**ORDINANCE NO. 2432**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE  
RENAMING A ROADWAY KNOWN AS TECH ONE EXTENSION  
ROAD TO TECHNOLOGY DRIVE**

**WHEREAS**, the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE has received a request to rename Tech One Extension Road to Technology Drive from Bechtel Plant Machinery, Inc., dated October 3, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, the MUNICIPALITY OF Monroeville has accepted said roadway pursuant to Ordinance No. 2429; and

**WHEREAS**, the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE deems it in the general health, safety and welfare of the Municipality to rename said roadway to Technology Drive.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained and enacted by Council for the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE at a meeting assembled; and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Council for the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE hereby amends Tech One Extension Road, as more fully set forth in Ordinance No. 2429, to be renamed as Technology Drive.

**SECTION 2.** The proper Municipality officials are hereby directed to take steps to rename Tech One Extension Road to Technology Drive.

**SECTION 3.** The proper Municipal officials are directed to direct the proper signage in accordance with the necessary Ordinances to rename said roadway, as more fully set forth herein.

**SECTION 4:** The property Municipal officials shall notify the requisite Postal Authority of said change in street name and provide the Postal Authority with a certified copy of this within Ordinance

**SECTION 5:** Any Ordinance which may conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same is, hereby repealed insofar as the same may conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6:** Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance, which may be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, be the same are hereby repealed insofar as the same may conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 6:** If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as

the intent of the Municipality that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


