

**ORDINANCE NO. 2458**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF  
MONROEVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.  
848, REGULATING TRAFFIC, PARKING, AND  
IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES.**

NOW THEREFORE, on September 8, 2009, BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Whereas Haymaker Road has been previously designated a "through highway" between Mosside Boulevard and Broadway Boulevard by virtue of Ordinance No. 848, Article II, Section 6, and,

According to the Federal Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) section 2B.05, B and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Publication 212 section 212.106,a,1 stop signs may be erected on streets entering a "through highway" Ordinance No. 848 will be amended as follows:


Section 2. Article II, Section 7, of Ordinance 848 is amended by the addition of the following single stop intersection:

<u>Stop Highway</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	<u>Through Highway</u>
Horizon Drive	Eastbound	Haymaker Road
