ORDINANCE NO. 2486

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2425 and 2461
SETTING FORTH THE MAKE UP OF THE INDIVIDUALS WHO
WILL CONSTITUTE THE SEVEN (7) MEMBER VOTING BOARD
AND ESTABLISH ANOTHER CATEGORY FROM WHICH MEMBERS MAY BE
SELECTED TO HOLD VOTING PRIVILEGES ON THE CONVENTION VISITORS
BUREAU OF GREATER MONROEVILLE; AND ESTABLISHING A SECOND EX
OFFICIO MEMBER FROM THE MONROEVILLE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE**

WHEREAS, Council for the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE adopted Ordinance No. 2425 which set forth an Interim Board of THE CONVENTION VISITORS BUREAU OF GREATER MONROEVILLE until February 10, 2009 pursuant to Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2425; and

WHEREAS, Council amended Ordinance No. 2425 by Ordinance No. 2461 dated December 8, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to further amend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2425 to establish another category from which members may be selected to hold voting privileges on the Convention Visitors Bureau of Greater Monroeville and establish a second ex officio member from the Monroeville Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, Council has now seated permanent voting members of the Board of THE CONVENTION VISITORS BUREAU OF GREATER MONROEVILLE; and

WHEREAS, Council is desirous of establishing a diversified cross section of permanent members to serve on said Board of THE CONVENTION VISITORS BUREAU OF GREATER MONROEVILLE.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by THE CONVENTION VISITORS BUREAU OF GREATER MONROEVILLE, as follows:

SECTION I: Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2425 is supplemented with the following:

The seven (7) Member Voting Board may be made up of individuals from the following entities:

- A. Four (4) members to be chosen from the major hotel and motel facilities in Monroeville; and
- B. One (1) member to be from a current sport or athletic attraction or endeavor; and
- C. One (1) member to be a current Restaurateur or Manager of a restaurant; and
- D. One (1) member selected between the current members of Pennsylvania General Assembly serving the Municipality of Monroeville. Said Legislature Officer shall not be subject to term limits; and
- E. In lieu of naming a member from category A through D, a Member may be selected from a major healthcare provider located in the Municipality; and
- F. A second ex officio member shall be selected from the membership of the Monroeville Chamber of Commerce; and
- G. No member of the Board can be a paid employee of the Board.

SECTION II: All other paragraphs of Ordinance No. 2425 and 2461 are affirmed by this Ordinance.


SECTION III: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following Ordinance or parts thereof are specifically repealed; and

SECTION IV. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Municipality of Monroeville that this Ordinance would have been adopted

had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


