ORDINANCE NO. 2501

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2425, WHICH CREATES AND ESTABLISHES A GREATER MONROEVILLE CONVENTION AND VISITOR'S BUREAU BOARD BY DEFINING WHEN A BOARD MEMBER SEAT IS AUTOMATICALLY DECLARED VACANT.

WHEREAS, council for the Municipality of Monroeville has previously created and established the Greater Monroeville Convention and Visitor's Board; and

WHEREAS, council for the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of establishing a criteria for declaring a board members seat vacant upon certain circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

SECTION I.

Any board member who is absent without prior excuse of the Board for four (4) consecutive Board meetings shall have said seat declared vacant by the Municipal Council at any public meeting of council.

SECTION II.

Municipal Council can fill said vacancy without further notice to the board member at any future public meeting.

SECTION III.

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


SECTION IV.


If any one or more of the sections of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be to be illegal or invalid or otherwise contrary to law, then such section or sections shall be null and void, but shall be deemed separable from the remaining section or sections, and shall in no way otherwise affect the validity or enforceability of this Ordinance.
