**ORDINANCE NO. 2540**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE  
AMENDING THE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF  
MONROEVILLE, CHAPTER A366, SECTION 6.16**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Municipality of Monroeville hereby replaces Section 3.7 of the Municipality of Monroeville Employee Handbook with the following language:

**SECTION 3. 7 - Volunteer Fire Fighters:**

3.7.1 Working Hour Call-Outs – An employee who is a volunteer firefighter/EMT/Medic other than a police officer or dispatcher may respond to a confirmed structure fire, hazmat, or life-threatening call during working hours provided that the employee first notifies his/her supervisor and that the call is within Monroeville Municipal Boundaries. Violation of this provision may result in reduced pay for the time abandoning his/her position.

3.7.2 Evening, Late-Night-Call-Outs - An employee who is a volunteer firefighter/ EMT/Medic other than a police officer or dispatcher who responds to a call during the evening or late –night and who is not released from his/her VFD station before 3:00 a.m., may call his/her department head before the start of the following work day to request permission to report to work late, or not at all, at the discretion of the department head and shall not be charged with personal leave days (i.e. vacation, personal).


3.7.3 VFD Training/Activities – VFD Training and any other related activities including, but not limited to, travel for pre and post inspection of newly ordered VFD vehicles during working hours shall be charged with personal leave days (i.e. vacation, personal).


**SECTION 2.** Any Ordinance in conflict with said ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of such conflict.
