ORDINANCE NO. 2647

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1512, SECTION 5, SUBSECTION 4(D)(3), TO EXCLUDE THE COMMUNITY PARK LOCATED AT 2399 TILBROOK ROAD AND AUTHORIZING THE MONROEVILLE FOUNDATION INC. TO OFFER NAMING OPPORTUNITIES FOR FACILITIES IN THE COMMUNITY PARK VIA APPLICATIONS SUBJECT TO FINAL APPROVAL BY MUNICIPAL COUNCIL; AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 2338 DELETING "THE COMMUNITY PARK PROJECT IS IN NEED OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO BUILD PHASE II OF THE PROJECT TO INCLUDE A RECREATION/COMMUNITY CENTER," AND TO DESIGNATE A PERIOD FOR WHICH NAMING RIGHTS SHALL EXPIRE.

WHEREAS, the Monroeville Community Park has many features and facilities that are anonymously identified; and

WHEREAS, naming of park features and facilities will assist the public in locating facilities; and

WHEREAS, naming opportunities are a recognized as having value to families, residents, and businesses in Monroeville; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5, sub-section 4(d)(3) is amended to add, "For the Community Park only features and facilities may be named for persons, organizations, or businesses upon application and approval by Municipal Council and approved identifying signage/inscription may be placed on or near the approved named feature or facility in accordance with standards designed and approved by the Municipality.

Section 2. The Monroeville Foundation, Inc., is designated as the representative of the Municipality of Monroeville to market and accept applications for naming of features and facilities in the Community Park subject to final approval of Municipal Council, and as such, shall be permitted to collect five percent (5%) of the naming-application-fee in order to continue their mission of the betterment of the Municipality of Monroeville.

Section 3. Amended facility naming application fees and designated naming expiration periods on the attached sheet.
