RESOLUTION NO. 89-55

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, REQUESTING THE COOPERATION OF ALL OWNERS/BUILDERS/DEVELOPERS AND CONTRACTORS TO HIRE MONROEVILLE RESIDENTS FOR THE BUILDING AND OPERATION OF COMMERCIAL BUSINESSES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is sensitive to the unemployment conditions in Western Pennsylvania and, specifically, in the Municipality of Monroeville; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of securing positions for residents of the Municipality of Monroeville in both the construction, development and operation of commercial businesses in the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville desires that owners, builders, developers and operators of commercial businesses in the Municipality of Monroeville voluntarily hire Monroeville residents for the development and operation of commercial enterprises in the Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby resolved as follows:

SECTION 1. The Council of the Municipality of Monroeville requests that the Planning Department include in the approvals of all cite plans and conditional uses for commercial developments in the Municipality that all owners, developers, contractors and operators of commercial establishments give first preference to the hiring of all Monroeville residents, who are qualified, to participate in the development and operation of their commercial operations in the Municipality of Monroeville.

SECTION 2. Any Resolution or Ordinance or part of a Resolution or Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
